While It May Seem Clear That International Partnerships Are Inevitable, Complexities In Agreements And Deep Inequalities Underlie Many Current Trends In These Partnerships (Kaguhangire-Barifaijo, M., & Namara, R.B., 2022)

- Investment In Infrastructure And Resources

Infrastructure Investment Is Critical To Fostering These International Collaborations. By Increasing Access To Technology And Educational Materials, Indonesian Educators Can More Easily Connect With Their Peers Around The World. Additionally, Investing In Professional Development Opportunities For Teachers Can Help Ensure That They Are Equipped With The Knowledge And Skills Necessary To Effectively Incorporate Global Perspectives Into Their Curricula. This, In Turn, Will Help Create A More Interconnected And Culturally Diverse Learning Environment For Students. Ultimately, By Prioritizing These Investments, Indonesia Can Position Itself As A Leader In Global Education And Prepare Its Students To Thrive In An Increasingly Interconnected And Interdependent World. At The National Level, The Decision-Making Process For Prioritizing School Interventions Is Made More Challenging By Resource Constraints And A Lack Of Information. Furthermore, There Is No Systematic Approach To Addressing Existing Infrastructure Improvement Needs With Resource Constraints In Mind (R, Fernandez Et Al., 2023).

- Empowering Teachers And Students To Adapt To The Global World

Teacher And Student Empowerment Requires A Multifaceted Approach That Includes Curriculum Development, Teacher Training, And Opportunities For International Exchange Programs. Most Teachers Complained About The Way They Manage Their Classrooms. Teachers Said That Student Behavior In The Classroom Depends On Their Attributes, How They Interact With Students, And Their Beliefs About Teacher Efficacy. Some Teachers Also Said That The Level Of Knowledge And Maturity Of Students Affects The Way They Manage Their Classrooms. If Someone Feels That It Is Impossible To Achieve Their Goals, Then It Will Cause Various Levels Of Fear, Stress, And Anxiety. This Will Lead To Negative Teacher Efficacy Which Will Cause Negativity, Fear, And Frustration, Which Is Reflected When They Give Up Before Starting The Task (Gamboa Et Al., 2021; Suico, 2021).

By Incorporating Global Perspectives Into The Classroom And Equipping Teachers With The Tools They Need To Effectively Teach Cross-Cultural Communication Skills, Indonesia Can Ensure That Its Students Are Prepared To Thrive In An Increasingly Interconnected World. Additionally, Fostering Partnerships

With Schools And Organizations In Other Countries Can Provide Valuable Opportunities For Students To Engage With Different Cultures And Broaden Their Horizons. By Investing In Teacher And Student Education, Indonesia Can Position Itself As A Leader In Global Education And Create A Brighter Future For Its Citizens. Rooted In A Teacher Leadership Framework That Emphasizes Teacher Inquiry, A Broader Understanding Of The Teacher's Role, And An Emphasis On Social Justice, The Teacher Leadership Collaborative (Tlc) Has Provided A Generative Environment For Educators Across The Career Spectrum To Process Their Experiences, Articulate Their Challenges, And Identify Ways To Enact Equity-Oriented Change (R, Buchanan Et Al., 2023).
